Ages: Currently enrolled dual high school students

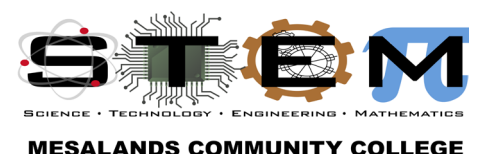
