Mesalands Community College in Tucumcari, NM and is an independent, non-profit accredited two-year community college that offers many traditional and non-traditional programs leading to Associate of Arts degrees, Associate of Applied Science degrees, and Applied Science and Occupational Certificates. The educational goals of these degrees and certificates are to prepare students for transfer to a four-year, degreegranting institution, or to obtain employment and/or to allow the students to upgrade their skills and knowledge for career advancement. Mesalands Community College also offers Adult Basic and Community Education courses for lifelong learning.

Quay County is home to some of the largest ranches in the nation, as well as the New Mexico State University Agriculture Science Center. Tucumcari and Quay County provide many opportunities for active learning for the Ag/Animal Science Program students. Mesalands Community College's Ag/Animal Science Program assists NMSU Ag Science Center with their annual bull test. In addition, the area feedlot provides additional active learning opportunities for the students. Additional opportunities within the area are also available for active, engaged learning.

The Ag/Animal Science Instructor reports to the Vice President of Academic Affairs. The principle responsibility as an instructor will be to teach courses in the discipline(s) for which the instructor has the necessary qualifications. This individual will perform any combination of the following tasks to assist the college in meeting its mission.

Essential Functions.

Instructs classes as assigned for 15-20 credit hours per semester with anything over 16 credits being an overload

Teaches one or more subjects for which qualified within prescribed curriculum Recruits students for the discipline area(s) taught

Uses and analyzes assessment and classroom techniques

Prepares and distributes to each student a syllabus for each course taught. A copy of each new syllabus must be filed with the office of the Vice President of Academic Affairs Stimulates class discussions and understanding of materials by students

Compiles bibliographies of specialized materials for outside reading assignments Compiles, administers, and grades examinations, or assigns this work to others Maintains currency in particular field of knowledge and applies this to instruction Performs related duties such as advising students on academic and vocational curricula, serving as advisor to student organizations, and performing faculty work through committees

Serves on committees to provide professional services to government and industry and to enable the work of the faculty and administration of the college to be accomplished Uses technology in the classroom

Uses distance education

Maintains office hours as agreed with the Dean of Instruction Performs other duties as assigned

Qualifications

Master's degree in discipline area or Master's degree and eighteen (18) graduate hours in discipline area; professional certification required as appropriate. Associate degree and/or community college experience preferred. Teaching experience preferred. A valid driver's license and satisfactory driving record may be required.

HOW TO APPLY

Applications are not considered complete until all required documents have been submitted. If the position for which you are applying requires a degree, certification or license, you MUST include a copy of your qualifying transcripts, certification or license in order to be considered. If your degree is from a country other than the United States, you must also include an evaluation from a NACES member evaluation agency indicating the U.S. equivalency of your degree. In addition to a completed, signed, and dated Mesalands Community College application (available online at mesalands.edu) the following must be provided:

- Resume
- Transcripts of all college work (Copies should only be submitted at time of application. Official transcripts will be required prior to job offer)
- Three (3) professional references.
- Cover letter
- Copy of current driver's license
