Applying for Financial Aid

- Step 1: Apply for Admission

 Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and apply for your FSA ID Number. Mesalands Community College School Code: 032063
- Step 4: Submit Additional Documents
- Step 5: Complete the Admissions Checklist
- Step 6: Register for Class

Helpful Hints for Financial Aid

- The FAFSA determines a student's eligibility for the Federal Pell Grant.
- It typically takes 3-5 days for a student's FAFSA information to be received by the Financial Aid office.
- Students should complete a FAFSA even if they feel they are not eligible.
- Students must use their prior year taxes to complete the FAFSA.
- A new FAFSA must be completed each academic year.
- A student under 24, has no dependents, and is not married is considered a dependent student. A dependent student must have parent tax information and signature to complete the FAFSA.
- The amount of an academic/merit based scholarship and/or grants may be determined by the number of credit hours a student has taken the previous semester, and/or the number of credit hours a student is enrolled in for the current semester.
- If a student needs assistance completing the FAFSA, they can make an appointment with Financial Aid.

Return to Title IV & Satisfactory Academic Progress

- If a student withdraws from all of his/her courses or fails all classes, a
 Return to Title IV(R2T4), calculation must be done to calculate how much
 Financial Aid the Student has earned for the semester.
- If a R2T4 calculation is done, a student must appeal to have their financial aid reinstated.
- Students must maintain a 2.0 GPA to continue getting financial aid.
 Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) is calculated after each semester.

- A network drive "M" on any computer the student logs into to store electronic files. The Lab computers delete all student files when rebooted, but a student's M drive is preserved until the semester ends.

Network responsibilities and behavior

- Over half of our bandwidth is consumed by entertainment traffic
- The (MPAA), (RIAA), and (HBO) actively search for copyright infringement activity on college campuses
- Higher Education Opportunity Act of 2008
 - Colleges and Universities must put into place plans "to effectively combat the unauthorized distribution of copyrighted material by users of the institution's network" without hampering legitimate education and research use, according to regulations that went into effect July 1, 2010
 - Colleges and Universities that do not comply risk losing their eligibility for federal student aid
 - Schools must educate their campus communities on the issue, and offer legal alternatives to downloading "to the extent practicable"
- Possible DMCA notifications to institutions include:
 - Preservation notices sent to Mesalands (preparatory to subpoena)
 - pre-offer settlement letters that Mesalands is being asked to forward (40 days from date on the letter to respond)
 - Letter forwarded to student with work infringed listed.
 - Minimum fine of \$750.00 per infringement.
 - Pre-Subpoena notifications option for individual to settle in advance of potential lawsuits
 - If you are sued by the entertainment industry, you could be liable for:
 - Up to \$150,000 per infringed work
 - Up to \$300,000 if the rights to distribute are owned by someone other than the copyright holder
 - The Family Education Rights and Privacy Act will not prevent Mesalands from releasing student information if subpoenaed
 - Because of the network registration and monitoring system, we already have identifying evidence stored
 - For your protection, you are urged to use legal methods of downloading music such as:
 - iTunes or similar music downloading service

Family Educational Rights/Privacy Act

It is the policy of Mesalands Community College to ensure the right of privacy and access to the student of his or her educational records in accordance with the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) of 1974, its amendments and the final rule of the U.S. Department of Health, Education and Welfare. FERPA gives students certain rights regarding their records including:

- 1. The right to inspect information contained in the student's educational records.
- 2. The right to request correction of records upon proof of error.
- 3. The right to prevent disclosure of records without consent, with certain exceptions, including directory information, as delineated in the College's complete policy.
- 4. The right to secure a copy of the College's complete policy (see Office of Enrollment Management).
- 5. The right to file a complaint with the U.S. Department of Education concerning alleged failures by the College to comply with the provisions of the Act.
- 6. The right to have directory information withheld





How to Opt In to the Emergency Alert Portal




