Summary:

Mesalands Community College is seeking a full-time faculty Director of the Small Business Development Center. The Director of the Small Business Development Center is responsible for all aspects of leadership and management of their center, including reviewing and maintain the allocated budget; ensuring compliance with all applicable laws, circulars and policies. The Director of the Small Business Development Center is expected to ensure their center aligns with the Statewide Business Plan, actively collaborate and partner with SBA Resource Partners and regional partners as approved by the Executive State Director (ESD). The Director of the Small Business Development Center is responsible for developing and maintaining strong relationships with their institution leadership and local legislators. The Director of the Small Business Development Center is responsible for providing counseling, training, and assistance to clients, small business owners, entrepreneurs or would-be entrepreneurs who request assistance in the service area of Mesalands Community College and other areas as requested. The Director of the Small Business Development Center organizes and administers the operations of the SBDC while promoting creation of new small businesses, and assistance to existing small businesses while adhering to the goals of the New Mexico Small Business Development Center network, which operates in partnership with the U.S. Small Business Administration (SBA) and the State of New Mexico. Employees have competitive salaries, excellent benefits and potential for growth.

Duties:

- Demonstrated organizational skills in planning, directing, and prioritizing multiple and complex assignments and projects.
- Ability to manage multiple matters simultaneously and to respond to rapidly shifting priorities or challenging situations.
- Knowledge and experience of forecasting and managing the budget.
- Ability to maintain confidentiality and has high ethical standards.
- Strong verbal and written communication skills, with the ability to present and communicate with multiple levels in a diverse, multi-cultural community.
- Strong knowledge and experience in providing effective customer service.

Qualifications:

Minimum Qualifications: The successful candidate must meet the following criteria:

Master's degree plus two (2) years of business work related experience or Bachelor's degree plus four (4) years of business work related experience. Must be able to provide prospective and existing small businesspersons and entities with counseling; training and specialized services concerning the formation, financing, management and operation of small businesses. Must demonstrate proven leadership and an understanding of issues impacting small business owners. A valid driver's license is required. Must be able to communicate effectively and demonstrate knowledge and skills in a variety of business functions. Must excel with regard to strategic thinking/problem solving. Preferred Qualifications:

Experience working with the SBDC and functional knowledge of the mission of the SBDC preferred. Knowledge of workforce and economic development community impact preferred.

Language skills:

Strong verbal, written, and interpersonal skills a must. Ability to read and interpret texts related to the discipline; documents such as safety rules, operating and maintenance instructions; and procedure manuals. Ability to write required reports and correspondence, and memos. Ability to effectively present information to individuals and groups of students and others from within Mesalands Community College and out in the community.

Ability to perform basic mathematical functions.

Reasoning ability:

Ability to apply principles of logical or scientific thinking to a wide range of intellectual and practical problems.

Technology skills:

Physical Requirements:
